# What are benefits of Standards?

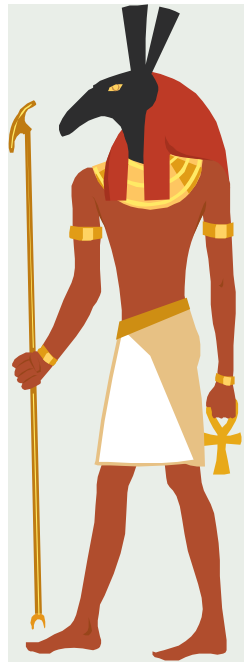


- *Standards protect*

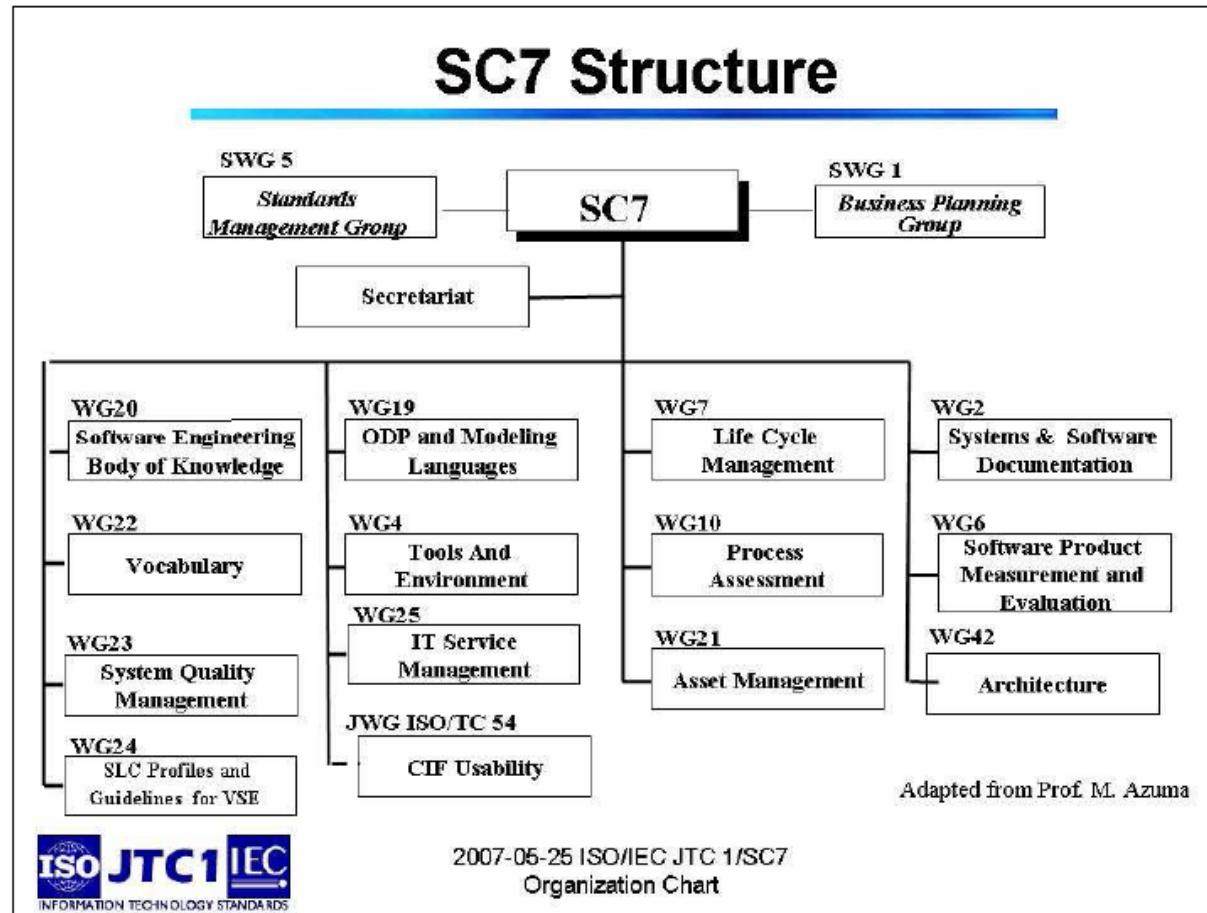


Figure 1 – Structure of ISO/IEC JTC1 SC7
